Biala-Stride Early Childhood Intervention

Our team provides a key worker and experienced children's therapists and educators to work with families and support their goals. We work with children and families at home, childcare, kindergarten and school. The service is for families of children from birth to school age with developmental delays or disabilities.

Access to this service is managed by the Department of Education and Training (DET). In November 2017 this will become an NDIS service.
