OTs can assist with:

- Advice and education about aids and equipment including:
 - Bathroom aids and equipment
 - Dressing aids
 - Hoists and slings
 - Kitchen aids
 - Personal alarms
 - Pressure care
 - Ramps and rails
 - Scooters
 - Specialised beds and mattresses
 - Specialised seating
 - Vehicle modifications
 - Wheelchairs (manual or power)
- Advice and information about community access, resources, supports and groups
- Education and techniques to manage fatigue
- Education for carers on safe lifting and transferring techniques
- Falls prevention advice
- Home Safety Assessment to provide recommendations for minor and/or major home modifications, and
- Support to apply for funding to assist with modifications and equipment if eligible.

We offer subsidised and fee-for-service health care with private health insurance rebates available. The cost of services depends on your income level and we will help you access funding you are eligible for. We support My Aged Care and National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) clients.
