




Helping with hearing and listening.





We provide comprehensive hearing assessments, and advice regarding management of any hearing loss. Our experienced audiologist works with children from nine months upwards.

We offer a number of services, including:

- Hearing assessments
- Management of hearing problems
- Auditory processing assessments
- · Ear wax removal
- · Development of swim and other ear plugs
- · Supplier of noise protection
- Hearing assessments prior to starting school
- Hearing assessments prior to seeing a paediatrician (which is a requirement)
- Visual reinforcement audiometry for children nine months to approximately two and half years old
- Play audiometry for children two and half years old to around six years old
- · Audiometry for children over six
- · Tinnitus and hyperacusis management, and
- Specialised testing for children with global development delay and autism spectrum disorder.

Reports are included with every assessment.
