



Our speech pathologists work closely with you to ensure your child's communication needs are met and goals are achieved.

This service is for children 0 - 12 years of age who need support with:

- · Speech clarity production of sounds
- · Language speaking and listening skills
- · Fluency stuttering
- · Voice quality of voice husky, nasal
- · Early Literacy readiness for reading and writing
- · School Readiness readiness to start school, and
- Social Skills social interaction and communication.

Our speech pathologists provide the following services:

- Initial screenings (including team screenings)
- Detailed communication assessments
- Individual/group therapy programs
- Consultation and advice for families
- Group education for parents
- Training and advice for service providers kindergarten teachers, child care staff, maternal and child health nurses, schools
- Home programs, and
- Referral to other services if required.

A hearing assessment is always recommended prior to an assessment by a Speech Pathologist. Please ask about our Audiology service.
