The Stable Housing Pilot Project has found that you are at a **LOW** / **MEDIUM** risk of losing your housing and entering homelessness.

Your local homeless service agency has been notified. A referral has been made to **Uniting Harrison**. Some information about their services is below.

If you don't hear from Uniting Harrison within three days, or your living conditions change, you should contact them directly. There is no cost for these services.

Please note, it may take some time to find a stable and safe home for you. The housing service staff are the best people to help.
