Our services are provided by a team of passionate health professionals.

Alcohol & Other Drugs Services

We work with adults, young people and families to support recovery and help reduce the harm of alcohol, medication or other drug use.

Audiology

Our audiologist provides hearing and listening services for adults and children, including hearing aid fittings.

We assist with a wide range of childhood developmental concerns & disabilities. Care is tailored to suit the needs of each child and family situation.

Doctors & Nurses

Doctors work alongside our nursing team to provide complete medical care. Telehealth appointments are available.

Dermatology nurses from The Royal Children's Hospital Eczema Clinic run family education workshops at our Hawthorn site.

Our exercise physiologist uses exercise, education and lifestyle changes to help people with health conditions or chronic diseases reduce health complications and improve strength, fitness and mood.


