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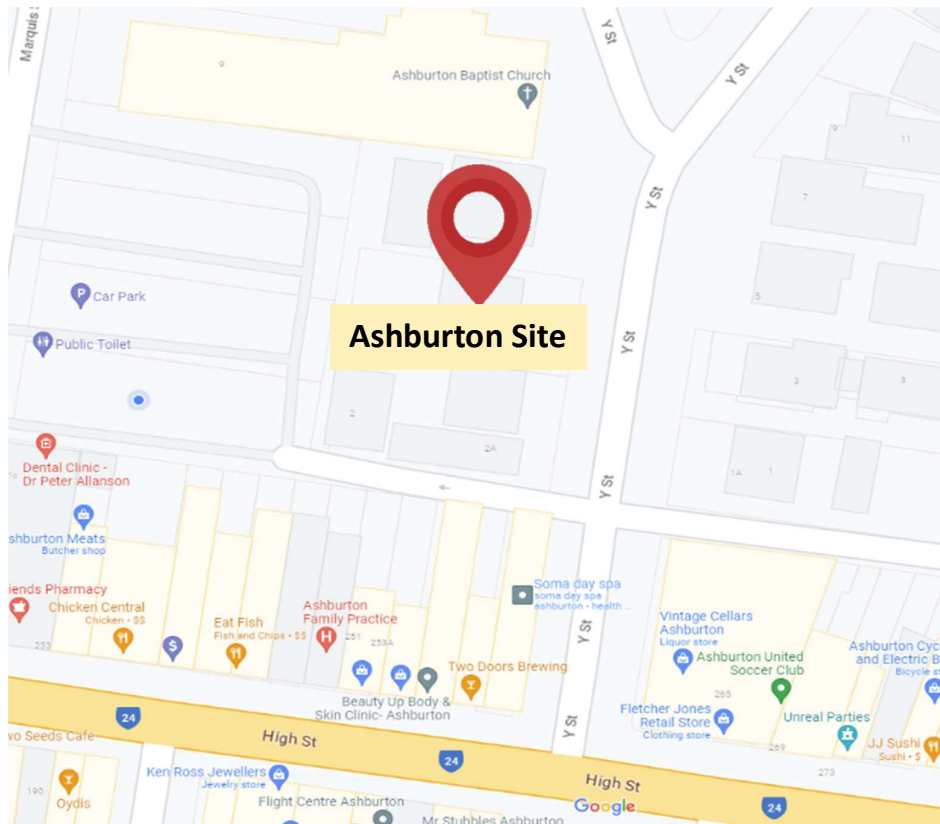
About this Access Key

2. Less than 1 minute walk from High Street Ashburton

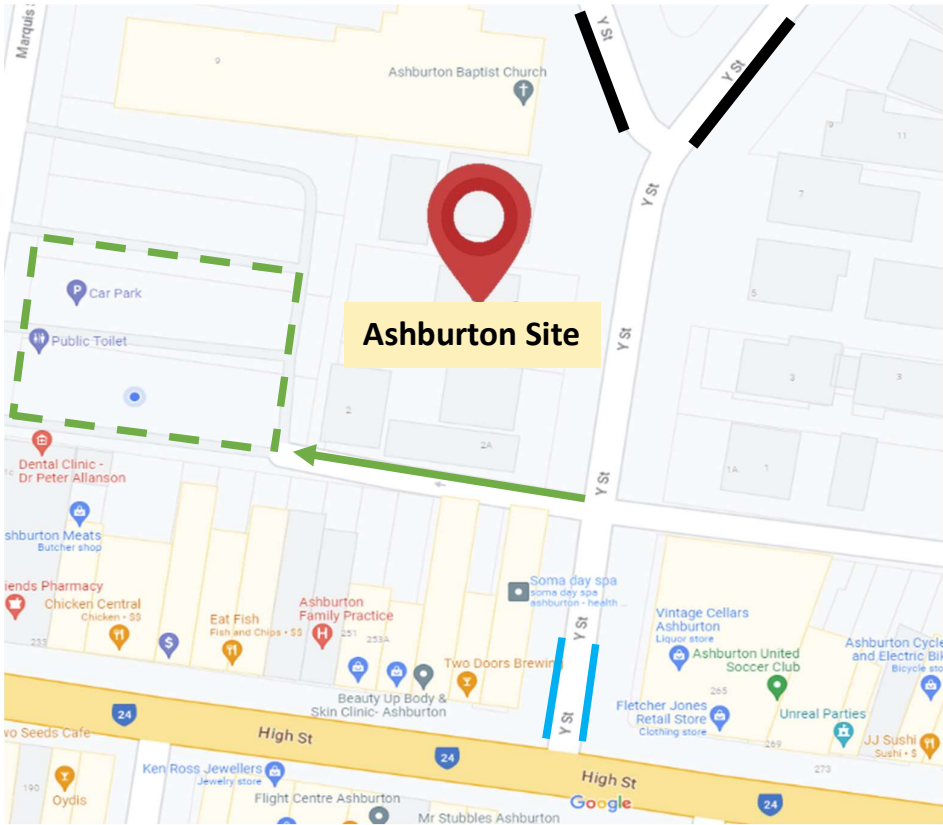

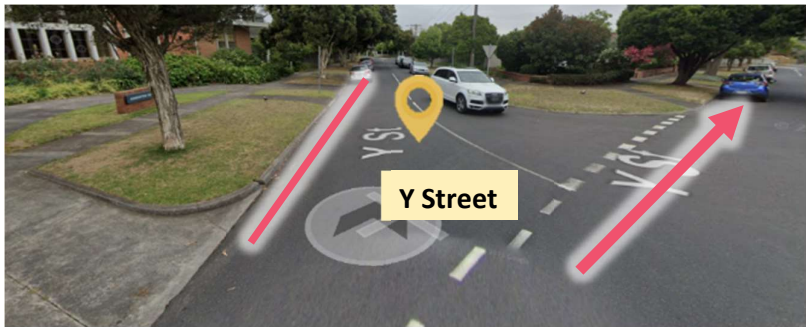

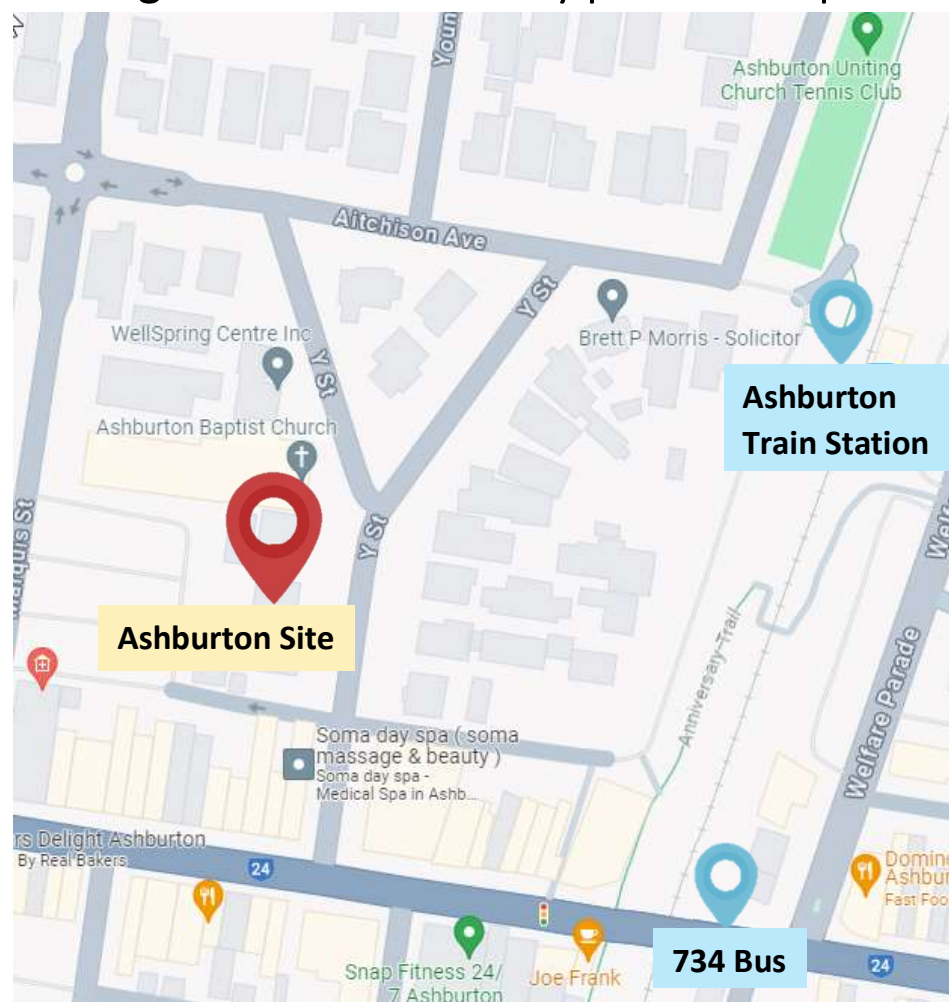
Getting to the Ashburton Site by car and parking

- Public car park via alleyway from Y Street (2 hours parking)

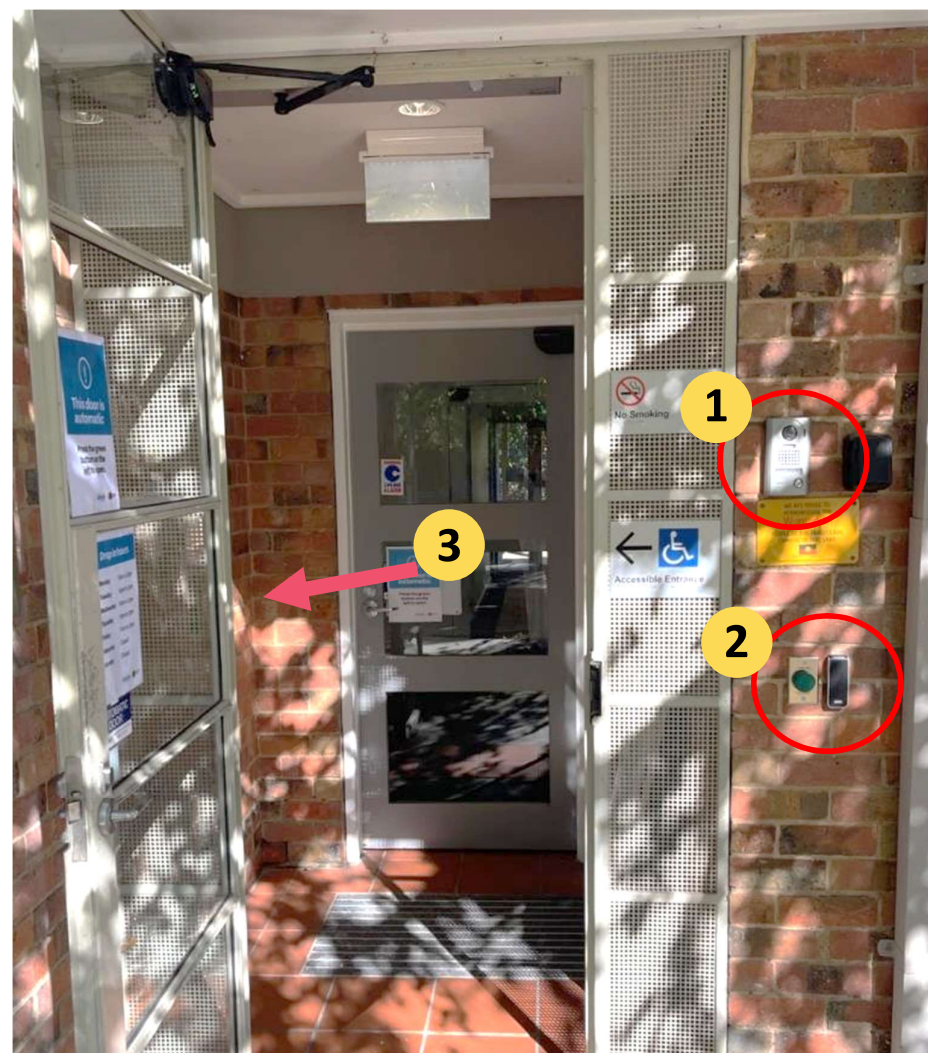


Getting to Ashburton Site by public transports

Reception

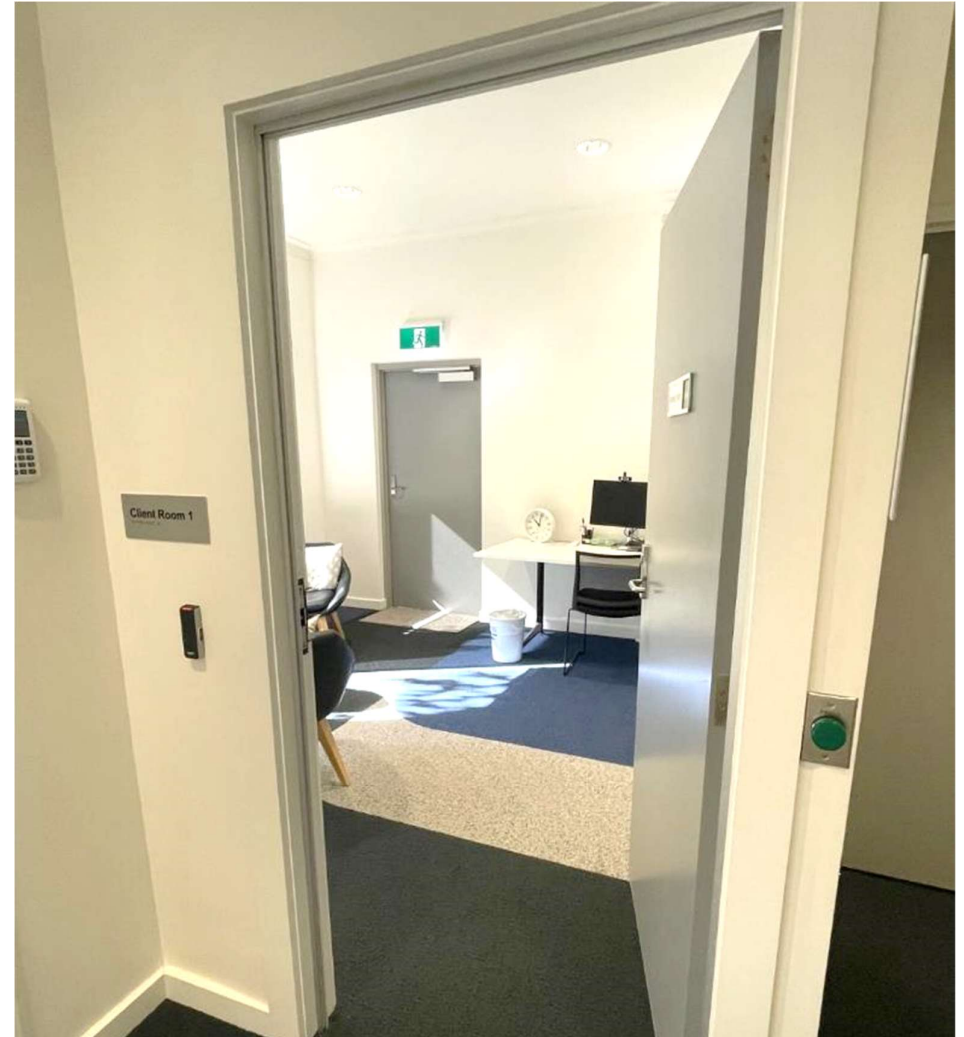


Reception is staffed by volunteers between 10am-2pm. Please ring the front door bell outside of these hours, and a

Consult rooms are available. The room has arm chairs, small table, telehealth set up (including monitor, desk and computer).

Inclusive toilet is located next to consult room 1. Standard handrail on the right to the toilet seat, wall mounted baby changing station and other safety facilities are available.

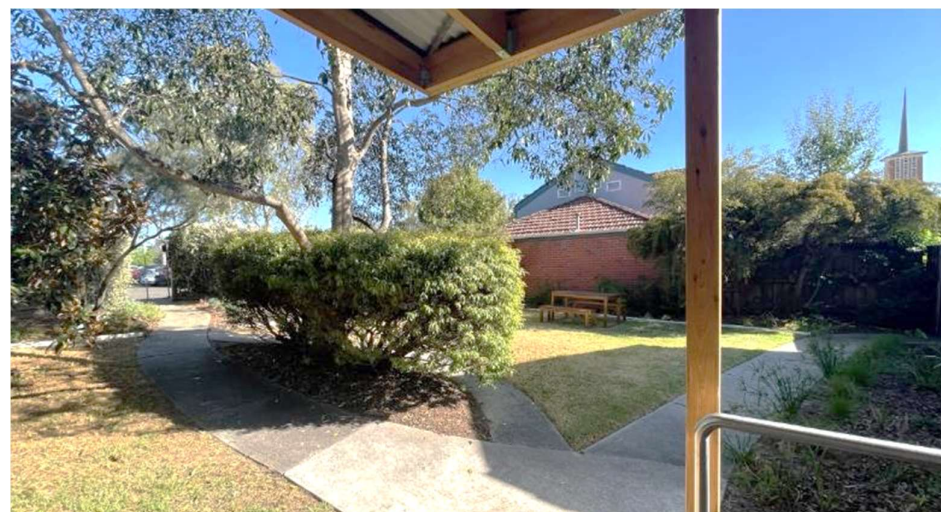
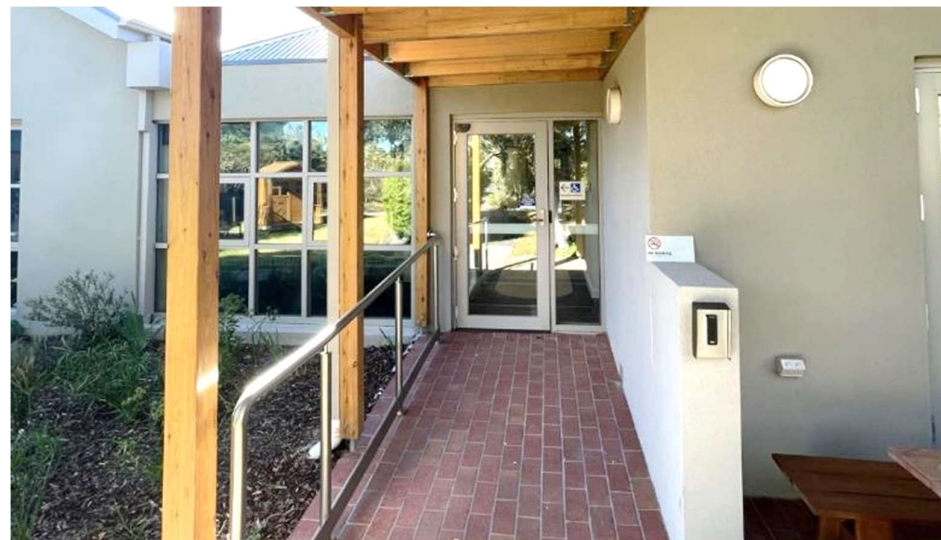
Kitchen *(Swipe card access only)*



Kitchen consists of dish washer, sink, hot/ cold water tap, Fridge, coffee pod machine and microwave.

Kitchen is located in the staff area which requires staff access. Please enquire from our team.

Backyard *(Swipe card access only)*



Can be accessed via a ramp and outdoor seating and tables are available.

Backyard is located at the back of the building and require staff access. Please enquire from our team.
