[Steps Mental Health](#) is delivered across the Inner and Outer East of Melbourne by AccessHC (lead agency), Carrington Health, Inspiro Community Health, Link Health and Community and Oonah Belonging Place.

This new team will deliver mental health care and support in the Inner and Outer East catchment as part of a community-based mental health service, with a focus on the mental health effects of COVID-19 on the Victorian community.

The new mental health workers will work together as a multidisciplinary team, which may include:

- Psychologists (including Provisional Psychologists under supervision)
- Social Workers and Mental Health Social Workers
- Mental Health Nurses
- Peer Support Workers
- Care Coordinators and Support Workers

The new staff will be employed at either AccessHC, Carrington Health or Inspiro Community Health (depending on the location) and will work closely with the existing Steps Mental Health Teams and Project Support Team to:

- Provide high quality, client centred and evidence-based mental health care
- Support the implementation of an integrated mental health stepped care model
- Work together to provide accessible, flexible and responsive services to meet the needs of the community
- Practice shared care principles, including use of collaborative care plans, care team meetings, clinical review and discharge planning
- Ensure services are delivered in a safe and culturally sensitive manner
- Ensure data and reporting requirements of the program are met

Applicants are expected to have relevant clinical experience and hold appropriate qualifications and registration as relevant to their role.
